- increase student engagement in learning through school wide positive behaviour support.

Our initiatives include:


- building teacher capacity to deliver balanced literacy instruction through school based coaching and collaborative planning
- building staff capability to support the use of student preferred Augmentative and Alternative Communication systems
- implementing Positive Behaviour for Learning across the school campus.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Increasing speech language pathology services by one day per week to support the implementation of a school wide balanced literacy approach and Aided Language Stimulation.	\$15 000
Engaging external consultants to support staff capacity building in Augmentative and Alternative Communication systems.	\$8 000
Utilising Regional Behaviour Support to aid the implementation of Positive Behaviour for Learning.	\$7 500
Purchasing relevant resources to support Augmentative and Alternative Communication and balanced literacy.	\$3 069
Providing opportunities for teachers to be involved in collaborative planning.	\$13 000
